Transitional Housing



Emmanuel Community Care Center (ECCC) was opened in 1992 as an outreach/advocacy center to serve the poor in the Girard area. Today it provides four units of transitional housing for homeless, single parent families, in addition to providing food, clothing, and emergency financial assistance services in response to the needs of community residents.



H.M. Life Opportunity Services in Akron and Northfield Center offers transitional housing to local, homeless, single parent families. Participants receive housing for up to two years while they work with a case manager to identify goals and determine a plan of action for themselves and their children. Residents must be willing to work actively in obtaining more education or job skill experiences. The goal is to lead participants to permanent housing and self-sufficiency.



FAITH House I and II are located in Lorain and are designed to meet the needs of homeless, single parent families. FAITH House I is a transitional housing program which works with various social services agencies to help residents gain permanent housing, self-sufficiency, and independence. FAITH House II provides homeless single-parent families with disabilities the opportunity for permanent housing with supportive services to assist them in gaining greater self-sufficiency.



Family Housing



Eastwood Village in Youngstown, Ohio offers one- and two-bedroom units to individuals and families whose circumstances may exclude them from home ownership. Residents have access to scheduled nurse visits, maintenance service, a lending book and video library, a community room, and city bus service with stops inside the “village.” Eastwood “villagers” are encouraged to use the facility’s picnic areas.



We are a regional organization who acts locally. At Humility of Mary Housing we work with others in our system who are providing quality housing and support services to those in need. By working together we improve the quality of the presence and service we bring to those in need on a local level.



Senior Housing



St. Patrick Manor in Wellington provides 50 units of affordable, quality senior housing in a comfortable atmosphere for independent living. A variety of services are available including regular blood pressure screenings, food delivery services provided by local stores, and an opportunity to participate in the area's senior services program.



The Villa at Marian Park in Akron provides 40 one-bedroom apartments for area seniors in a comfortable, affordable and convenient location. Located in the Firestone Park area of Akron, the facility is near bus lines providing access to shopping, restaurants, physician offices, churches, the post office and a number of social and services organizations. The residents schedule many of their own group activities and events.



Saint Martha Manor in Akron is a recent addition to the HM Housing Ministry's senior facilities. Saint Martha's blends new construction with remodeling of the former school building to offer a total of 36 apartment units, with one or two bedrooms. The facility features below-market rent, a security controlled entrance, air conditioning, kitchen appliances, a community room with attached kitchen and several multi-purpose lounges.



St. Timothy Manor and St. Timothy Park Apartments in Garfield Heights is adjacent to the campus of Holy Spirit Catholic Church and provides 80 units of comfortable, affordable senior living. Residents are welcome to join the many social activities available at both facilities. Residents have access to public transportation and programs provided by Garfield Heights Senior Center.
