Sister Loretta Rafter, HM Scholarship 2020 Scholarship Fund Application

Purpose: To provide scholarships to current residents of Humility of Mary Housing who show motivation to achieve greater knowledge, share the values of Humility of Mary Housing, and intend to pursue higher education at a college/university or other post-secondary educational institution or training program, or are currently enrolled in higher education in a college/university or other post-secondary educational institution or training program which will assist the applicant in gaining or increasing employment.

- DEADLINE for scholarship applications is Friday, May 1, 2020 at 4:00 pm (no exceptions)
- Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements
- Refer to application process for a list of the supporting documents needed
- If any question does not apply to you, please put "N/A" in the space
- Type or print legibly; illegible applications will be returned
- You will be notified via mail in June regarding the status of your application
- If you have questions about the application, please contact a member of the team member who provided you with the application.
- The Humility of Mary Housing Sr. Loretta Scholarship Fund's policy is to renew scholarships to students whom have kept a grade point average (GPA) above 2.5 and are enrolled in a minimum of six (6) credit hours of coursework per semester or enrolled at least part-time in an educational training program to assist the applicant in gaining or increasing employment. This scholarship is renewable up to four (4) times, for a maximum total award of \$8,000 over a four-year period. Scholarship awards amount may vary based on cost of program applicant will attend and availability of scholarship funds.
- Scholarship funds will only be awarded to the student's college, university, or training institution upon evidence of registration at an accredited post-secondary institution or training program.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicant must be a resident of Summit County Humility of Mary Housing. Applicants may be heads of household or youth household members.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior OR enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution or educational training program within the year of the scholarship award
- Applicant must demonstrate values consistent with the values of Humility of Mary Housing

Application Process

Applicant must submit the following items:

- Completed application
- Personal essay of no more than 500 words describing: (1) the effect this award will have on your future, (2) defining your career goals, (3) identifying which one of the five core values of Humility of Mary Housing (respect, integrity, justice, compassion, collaboration) that you most identify with, and (4) outlining your plan for carrying that value into your future career.
- One (1) letter of recommendation from an individual outside your immediate family with knowledge of your experience and goals, and who can attest to your ability to continue your education and reach your career goals.
- An official and most recent high school or college/university transcript with a cumulative GPA.
 For those using the scholarship to enroll in a training program not in a college or university,
 proof of eligibility for that program must be given (i.e. a copy of high school diploma or GED).
